1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.								
2	remo	Start with the upper grille. Pop hood, remove the black plastic cover (on top of OEM grille/front panel) from vehicle. Then remove the five 10mm retaining nuts from the rear of the grille shell. Pull the grille shell forward and remove from the hood.							
3	rear stud	of the grille. Ma	ake sure	aded holes on the the three longer o shorter ones ar		3-10-24× 1 1/2 2-10-24× 3			
4	Cen	Center the grille into the opening of the factory grille shell. Be sure the studs are through the OEM grille shell.

6	Continue to the lower section. Test fit grille into the bumper opening. Thread a stud in each nut welded to the grille. Thread the three studs into the holes on the back of the billet. A small amount of liquid thread lock may be applied to the threads**. BE SURE NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE STUDS (Over-tightening can cause dimpling to the face of the billets).					
7	Attach the L brackets as shown. Use the lock nuts to secure the brackets to the grille.					
8	Re-center the grille in place; slide a u-nut onto the back of the bumper cover. Use the screws to secure the brackets; it may be necessary to slightly bend the brackets to achieve the proper angle.					
9	Make sure the grille is centered and tighten the fasteners.					
10	Installation completed.					

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
