Step	Description	illustration			
1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.				
2	Pop hood, remove the black plastic cover (on top of OEM grille / front panel) from vehicle. This will allow access to the rear of the grille shell.				
3	Remove the plastic clips on the under hood cover.(Fig 1)				
4	Removing the under hood cover.(Fig 2)				
5	Remove bolts that secure grille shell to the core support.(Fig 3)				







- 6 Give the plastic screw fasteners on the grille shell 1/2 turn.(Fig 4)
- 7 Give the plastic screw fasteners located on the bottom of the grille shell 1/2 turn.(Fig 5)
- 8 Remove grille shell.(Fig 6)

9	Note: The plastic welds that need to be removed.(Fig 7)			
10	Using a chisel or sharp screwdriver will remove the plastic welds.(Fig 8)			







12 Insert the upper grille into factory grill. Mark and drill bracket center hole location. (Fig 10&11)



Now remove grille center section as shown.(Fig 9)



- Place a U-clip nut into each holes, and attach it to the factory grille shell. Secure billet grille using the screws from the back side of the OEM grille shell.
- 14 Repeat steps 12&13 to install lower grille.



Red marks are the holes position

15 Make sure the billet grille is centered and tighten the fasteners. but do not over-tighten.

Reinstall the black plastic cover which was removed in step 8. Installation completed!!!
