



Step	Description	illustration
1	Identify the grille and hardware with parts list.	
2	Remove license plate from the bumper.	 
3	Attach U-clips on the tab, make sure the small hole on the clip is pointing at the opposite direction from the tab bending angle.	
4	Place screws through the welded tabs on the back of the grille, and attach a tab on the end of each screw.

5	Hold the billet insert up to the opening of the factory shell, and make sure that it is centered.		
6	<p>Rotate the tab so it is vertical and secured behind the bumper shell. You may use a screwdriver or any tool handy for you for rotation. Tighten the screws, but not over tighten.</p>		
7	Installation completed.
