| 2  | Open the hood, remove the black plastic cover (on<br>top of OEM grille / front panel) from vehicle. This<br>will allow access to the rear of the grille shell. I<br>remove the Phillip screws along the top of the<br>factory grille shell   |             |           |             |      |                                   | N/A          |                               |     |             |
| 3  | Cut the center cross bars cut of the grill shell. Leave<br>a 3" - 4" plastic lip along the top of the opening<br>from corner to corner (note shaded area in the<br>diagram).Make your final cuts as close to the face<br>of the grille as possible. This will allow the billet<br>insert to sit flush to the front of the grille shell. Use a<br>file or sand paper to smooth a straight edge around<br>the opening. |             |           |             |      |                                   |              |                               |     |             |
| 4  | Center the billet behind the grille shell opening with<br>the upper brackets against the $3'' - 4''$ lip. Be sure<br>the billet is correctly positioned and mark where the<br>vertical dowels contact the grille shell on the<br>bottom. Drill a $1/8''$ hole at each bar. Rivet the billet<br>in place. Drill a $1/8''$ hole at each top bracket and<br>install a screw and clip                                    |             |           |             |      |                                   | N/A          |                               |     |             |
