Center grill behind opening from back side of the grille shell. Attach (4) L brackets onto the weld tab on the rear of the billet grille.

6	Using the two (2) brackets with the short leg measuring 1 ", attach your billet grill to the factory grill shell attachment posts at the bottom of the grill. You will need to drill two (2)1 /4 "holes to attach the brackets to the grill shell.	Drill hole on grille shell				
7	Use the other two (2) L brackets to attach the grill at the top of the grill shell. You will need to drill two (2) 1/4"holes to attach the brackets to the grill shell.					
8	Make sure that the grill is all the way forward against the grill shell; if it is not, loosen the bolts and adjust it so that it is.					
9	Reinstall grill shell on vehicle usina factory hardware.					
10	Installation completed!!!
