


Install Notes: Overlay Replacement Drill Cut

Step	Description	illustration
1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.	
2	To prevent scratching the grille, apply masking tape to the following: Lincoln logo, top two cross bars, center cross bar and lower cross bar of the factory grille. Test fit the mesh inserts over the factory grille; identify the correct locations. Open the hood. Use a screwdriver to unscrew the fasteners; then pull them out. Remove the screws holding the inner fender wells to the bumper (1). Reaching up through the fender well; Remove the screw in the upper corner connecting the bumper to the corner of the fender. Remove the bolts on the lower bottom motor cover to allow the bumper cover to release. Where the bumper and fender connect; slightly pull the bumper away from the fender and unclip the bumper (2). Repeat on the other side. Remove the bumper slightly and unclipped the lights. Remove the bumper and set it on a soft surface.	
		
3	Thread a stud in each nut welded to the grille. Place the bumper grille into position. Place a flange bracket, kept nut and washer onto each stud (3). With the bumper grille centered; tighten the grille till snug. Re-install the grille assembly back onto the vehicle.	
4	Installation completed!!!
