Step	Description					illustration				
1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.									
2	Pop hood, remove the black plastic cover (on top of OEM grille / front panel) from vehicle. This will allow access to the rear of the grille shell.									
3	The upper grille must be removed to install the bumper grilles. Identify the correct locations for the three grilles. Remove six plastic fasteners along the top of the grille; use a small screwdriver to pull the center from each fastener (1). Remove five 10mm bolts securing the radiator cover. Remove two 10mm bolts securing the coolant overflow tank; slide it back for clearance (2). Next, push the radiator cover back; depress the clips securing a wiring harness to the cover, remove (2). Remove five 10mm nuts behind the grille. Depress the molded clips retaining the grille and remove from the front.									
4	Thread a stud in each nut welded to the grille. Place the center grille into the bumper opening. Install the L brackets, washers and nuts to secure the grille; wrap the L bracket around the plastic lip in the opening (3). Tighten the hardware until the grille is held securely in place.									
5	Test fit one of the end grilles over the factory bumper insert (4). An angled tab installs on the out edge; a threaded stud installs towards the center. Two holes are required in the factory inserts to install these grilles (5); one for the tab and one for the stud. Drill a 1/4" hole for the angled tab first. Slide the angled tab into the holes; rotate the grille so the threaded stud contacts the factory insert. Mark the location for the hole; remove the grille. Drill a 1/4" hole for the stud (6). Install the angled tab on the end (7); then rotated the threaded stud into the mounting hole. Secure a washer and nut from the rear. Repeat installation process on the other grille.									
6	Make sure the billet grille is centered and tighten the fasteners.but do not over-tighten.									
7	Re-install the wiring harness and radiator cover. Secure the coolant overflow tank.
