Step Description						illustration			
1		Identify the grille & hardware with parts list. Start with the bumper grilles. Raise the vehicle to a comfortable working level and place the vehicle on jack stands.							
2	edge	Remove the lower cover underneath the bumper cover. Remove the 7mm hex head screws across the bottom edge (A), the six plastic push pins (B), in each wheel well openings and the two 10mm hex bolts (C). The lower panel can now be removed.							
3		From underneath the vehicle, remove the two retaining clips that secure each factory lower vent insert to the bumper cover. Use a flat blade screwdriver to push the clips straight up to remove							
4		Pull the vent inserts out and slide the outer mounting tab out of the slot in the bumper cover to remove (not reused, Touring or Limited model shown).							
5	prop	Cut out the supplied template and align it into the bottom of the driver side bumper cover recess. Once properly aligned, tape it into place and mark the hole locations with an awl or similar pointed tool. Remove the template and flip it over and repeat the procedure on the passenger side bumper cover recess.							

The instruction here is for your reference only. You may need to bend the billet grille bars or tabs a little bit to adjust to fit. We strongly recommend the professional installer for best result. Please use masking tape and tape the OEM grille shell along the edge to protect your vehicle during installation. We are not responsible for any damage caused by the installation. Thank you for choosing our product!



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6	Use a 9/64" drill bit to drill through the marks made in the bumper cover in Step 5.						
7	Remove the three phillips screws retaining each driving light and remove the driving lights from the bumper cover. Disconnect the wiring and place the lights in a safe place for future reinstallation.						
8	Align the mesh sections over the back of the frames and use a vise grips or pliers to bend the securing tabs over against the mesh to retain it.						
9	You will need to bend the upper retaining tabs at both relieved slots (as shown). Start by bending the tab closest to the hole (A) slightly more than 90 degrees. Bend the tab at the slot closest to the frame (B) slightly more than 90 degrees. Make sure you fold the tabs back towards the side that the mesh is secured to.

10	Use masking tape to protect the factory paint from overspray. Tape up to the center of the mounting holes drilled in Step 6 and completely around the factory recess where the edges of the mesh sections line up.						
11	Align and center the mesh inserts into the lower bumper cover. Once the mesh sections are centered in the recess openings, use a 3/32" drill bit to drill through the center of the upper tab mounting holes for future 5/8" Truss Head Tapping Screw installation.						
12	Use a scotch brite pad or 360-400 grit sandpaper and scuff the paint on the exposed surfaces.						
13	Apply flat or semi-gloss black paint to the recesses and allow to dry.						



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

A small amount of over-tightening may create dimples on the face of the grille (DO UDS). Next thread the standard nuts onto the studs halfway a height tool and will not need tightening as well as giving you a II do in the following steps.			
23	Center the grille into the opening; Insert the mounting legs (Fig.7) into the four holes along the bottom. Slide the upper studs into the upper mounting holes (Fig.10). Now you can make any adjustment to the flange nuts. Check the alignment the grille in comparison to the face of the bumper cover. It may be necessary to remove the grille and bend the face of the grille to have the proper contour. Be sure to protect the face of the grille with a towel or soft surface. Once you have properly fitted and aligned the grille, install 4#10 washers and nylon lock nuts (Fig.11-12) onto the studs. Make adjustments to the depth of the grille if needed. Use a wrench to snug the Nylon-lock-nuts tight (Fig.11-12). Do not overtighten the hardware.
