


Step	Description	illustration		
1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.			
2	Open the hood and remove the outer phillips screws, outer push fasteners and the center 10mm hex bolt to release the bumper cover from the support brackets(Fig 1).			
3	Use wide masking tape and carefully mask around the factory grille, lower bumper opening and cover the front emblem prior to factory grille removal(Fig 1).			
4	Remove the four factory phillips screws from the inside of the factory grille (one each side at the top corners) (Fig 2).			






- Remove the two center screws. They are on either side of the factory hood emblem (Fig 3).

 Once the screws are removed, squeeze the mounting clips and pull the grille straight out to remove (Fig 4-1).
- Remove the front license plate bracket if equipped (Fig 4-2).
