Step	Description	illustration
1	Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.	

**FOR CENTER GRILLE:**

2	Start by removing the headlamp bolts there are total of three per side.	3	Remove the turn signal lamp and unplug the lamp socket.
4	The headlamp has a plastic clip on the bottom push up in order to free the headlamp.	5	Unplug headlamp bulb socket from the backside.
6	With the headlamp out of the way remove the corner bolt located in the headlamp area.	7	Remove the second bolt.
7	Unplug fog lamp socket.	8	Remove bolts located on the top side of the bumper.
9	Remove the front fender splash shield plastic clips located in front of the wheel.	10	Using a socket wrench remove the corner bolt behind splash shield. ( Bolt is in the vertical position)
11	Remove plastic clips located on the bottom side of the bumper cover.	12	Bumper cover can now be removed.
13	Insert grille into bumper opening from the front side. Hold firmly in place and mark mounting tab center holes.	14	Using 3/16 drill bit drill for mounting screws.
15	Mounting screw & flat nuts.	16	Fasten grille from the backside using supplied hardware.

**FOR SIDE GRILLES:**

1	Remove original vent covers and then place the grille in from the front side.	2	Hold grille firmly in place and mark the screw tab location using a sharp scribe.
3	Using a 3/16 drill bit. Drill mounting screw hole location.	4	Note the drilled hole.
5	Install "U" Nut onto mounting tab.	6	Fasten mounting screws from the backside.
