





STEP 1

Install (4) Pedals onto the step bars with (24) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (24) M8 Large Flat Washers and (24) M8 Lock Washers.


IMPORTANT: Don't hit the pedal with any metal hummer within pedal installation, or the pedal will be damaged.



STEP 2




(Fig 1) Passenger Side Mounting Locations

Start the installation from the passenger side of the vehicle. Locate the mounting locations along the bottom and inner side of the body panel, (**Fig 1**).

NOTE: It will be helpful for identifying the mounting holes to hold up a mounting bracket in place.

STEP 3


(Fig 2) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location

Remove rubber plugs from the Passenger side front location if equipped. Select (2) M8 Clip Nuts. Slide each Clip Nut into the large hole and over the smaller hole next to it. Line up threaded nut on the Clip Nut with smaller hole in body panel, (Fig 2).



STEP 4


(Fig 3) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installation




(Fig 4) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed

Select (1) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM/PRM**). Attach the Bracket to the (2) installed M8 Clip Nuts with (2) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (**Figs 3 & 4**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 5


(Fig 6) Passenger Center Mounting Bracket Installation

Move to the Passenger Side Center Mounting location, (Fig 5). Repeat Steps 2—4 to install Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (PCM), (Fig 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 5) Passenger Side Center Mounting Location



STEP 6

Move to Passenger Side Rear Mounting location, (Fig 7). Repeat Steps 2—4 to install the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (PFM/PRM), (Fig 8). Do not tighten hardware at this time.

(Fig 9) Thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer on each T-Bolt Before Inserting into the bar tube!!! Insert the T-bolt with M8 Plastic Washer in the slot on the step bar and rotate the T-bolt to 90°!!

STEP 7

Once all (3) brackets have been installed, select (6) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer on each T-Bolt, (**Fig 9**). Install the (6) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts with plastic washers in the slots on the assembled Passenger side step bar. Rotate the T-Bolts to 90 degree, thread down the M8 Plastic Washers against the step bar (**Fig 10**).

<u>NOTE:</u> The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the T-Bolt from falling into the bar tube during installation.

STEP 8

Attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the Mounting Brackets with (6) M8 Plastic Washers, (6) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, (6) M8 Large Flat Washers, (6) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts, (Fig 11). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 9

Level and adjust the assembled Step Bar properly and tighten all hardware.

Move to the other side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-8** to install the other side step bar.

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
