



The instruction here is for your reference only. We strongly recommend the professional installer for best result. We are not responsible for any damage caused by the installation.

STEP 1

Install the Step Pads onto the step bars with (16) M6X1-20mm T-Bolts, (16) M6 Large Flat Washers and (16) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts.

IMPORTANT: Don't hit the step pad by any metal hummer within step pad installation, or the step pad will be damaged.




Note: Rotate 90° after inserting the T-Bolts into the

Channel!!!

STEP 2


(Fig 1) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location Pictured

Starting from the passenger side of the vehicle. Remove the front body mount bolt, (**Fig 1**). Do not remove rubber bushings.

STEP 3




(Fig 2) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed

Attach the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**) to the body mount reusing the factory hex bolt, (**Fig 2**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 4

Locate the (2) factory holes at the bottom of the frame beside the passenger side front body mount, **(Fig 3)**. Insert (1) M10 Nut Plate into the oval hole and line up the threaded nut with the round hole, **(Fig 3)**.

NOTE: Nut Plate and Support Brackets are not required on **11- Up 2500/3500** models.

STEP 5




(Fig 4) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installation


(Fig 5) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installation

Attach the flat end of the Passenger Front Support Bracket (PFS) to the installed M10 Nut Plate with (1) M10X1.5-30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M10 Flat Washer and (1) M10 Lock Washer, (Fig 4 & 5). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Up to 2010 2500/3500 Models:

Note that the Front Support Bracket will not reach up to the Mounting Bracket, **(Fig 5)**. Tighten the Support Bracket to the M10 Nut Plate in the frame. Carefully push up on the Support Bracket until it reaches the inside hole in the Mounting Bracket. Bolt the Support Bracket to the hole in the Mounting Bracket with (1) M10X1.5-30mm Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Hex Nut, **(Figs 5 & 6)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

NOTE: Bend Support Bracket up by hand to meet the inner hole in the Front Mounting Bracket.



STEP 6

Move to the Passenger Side Rear body mount. Repeat **Steps 2 –5** to attach the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket to the body mount, **(Fig 7).** Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 7

Once (2) passenger side brackets are installed, attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the Mounting Brackets with (4) M6X1-20 T-Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers and (4) M6x1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (Fig 8). Do not fully tighten hardware.

STEP 8


Properly level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 9

Move to the Driver side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-8** for the Driver Side Step Bar installation.
