



STEP 1

Install (4) Pedals onto the step bars with (24) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (24) M8 Large Flat Washers and (24) M8 Lock Washers.

IMPORTANT: Don't hit the pedal with any metal hummer within pedal installation, or the pedal will be damaged.




STEP 2


(Fig 1) Passenger Front / Rear Brackets Assembly

Starting on the passenger side of the vehicle. Assemble Passenger Front/Rear Mounting Bracket (**PFM/PRM**) & Passenger Front/Rear Support Bracket (**PFS/PRS**) with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Nylon Lock Nut, (**Fig 1**)

NOTE:

* Driver Front & Rear Mounting Brackets are universal.

* Driver Front & Rear Support Brackets are universal.

STEP 3




(Fig 3) M8 Clip Nut Installed (On Passenger Side Front Mounting Location)

Locate the (2) holes on the pinch weld, (Fig 2). Next locate the rectangular opening and (2) small holes in the inner body panel directly above the holes in the pinch weld, (Fig 2 & 3). Only (1) hole on the pinch weld and (1) small hole on the inner body panel will be used to mount the bracket.

It will be helpful to Identify the mounting locations by holding up Brackets in place.


NOTE: The holes on the inner panel may be covered with sealing tape or insulation, remove sealing tape if equipped.

STEP 4

Slide (1) M8 Clip Nut into the rectangular opening with the nut towards the inside. Line up the threaded nut on the clip with the round hole, (**Fig 3**).

STEP 5


Attach the Assembled Passenger Front Mounting Bracket to the installed M8 Clip Nut with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (Fig 4). Align the bottom hole on the front Bracket with the (1) hole on the pinch weld. Secure the Bracket to the pinch weld using the included (1) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8X1.25 Hex Nut, (Fig 4).

NOTE: Insert the bolts up from the bottom of the pinch weld and through the Bracket. Do not tighten hardware at this time.



STEP 6


Move to the Passenger Side Center Mounting Location of the vehicle, (**Fig 5**). Insert (1) M8 Clip Nut into the rectangular opening and line up with the single small round hole in the body panel. Then locate the (1) hole on the pinch weld. It will be helpful for Identifying the mounting locations by holding up the Mounting Bracket (**PCM**) in place.

STEP 7

Attach the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (**PCM**) to the installed M8 Clip Nut with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (**Fig 6**). Line up the lower hole on the Bracket with the mounting hole on the pinch weld. Bolt the Bracket to the pinch weld with (1) M8X1.25 -25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8X1.25 Hex Nut. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.




STEP 8

Continue moving to the Passenger Side Rear Mounting location (Fig 2). Repeat Steps 2-5 for Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (PFM/PRM) installation .


STEP 9

Once all (3) brackets have been installed, select (4) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer on each T-Bolt, (**Fig 7**). Install the (4) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts with plastic washers in the slots on the assembled Passenger side step bar. Rotate the T-Bolts to 90 degree, thread down the M8 Plastic Washers against the step bar (**Fig 8**).

<u>NOTE:</u> The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the T-Bolt in place to avoid falling into the tube during installation.

STEP 10

Attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the Mounting Brackets with (4) M8 Plastic Washers, (4) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers, (4) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 9**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

NOTE: the Passenger Front & Rear Mounting Brackets are located under the pedals. Slide (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into the channels at the bottom of two pedals (**Fig 10**). And secure the Passenger Front & Rear Mounting Brackets to the pedals with (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 9**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 11

Level and adjust the assembled Step Bar properly and tighten all hardware.

Move to the other side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-10** for the other Side Step Bar installation.

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
