

STEP 1

Install the Step Pads onto the step bars with (16) M6X1-20mm T-Bolts, (16) M6 Large Flat Washers and (16) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts.

IMPORTANT: Don't hit the step pad with any metal hummer within step pad installation, or the step pad will be damaged.







STEP 2

Assemble following mounting brackets and support brackets together with (2) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Nuts:

- (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket (**DFM**) & Driver Front Support Bracket (**DFS**) (Fig 1).
- (2) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**) & Passenger Front Support Bracket (**PFS**) (Fig 2).



(Fig 1) Driver Front Brackets Assembly





STEP 3






(Fig 4) M8 Clip Nuts Installed (On Driver Side Front Mounting Location)

Starting on the driver side of the vehicle, locate the (2) holes on the pinch weld, (Fig 3). And then locate the rectangular opening and (2) small holes on the inner body panel directly above the holes on the pinch weld, (Figs 3&4). Only (1) hole on the pinch weld and (1) small hole on the inner body panel will be used. It will be helpful for Identifying the mounting locations by holding up Brackets in place.

NOTE: The holes on the inner panel may be covered with sealing tape or insulation, remove sealing tape if equipped.



STEP 4

Slide (1) M8 Clip Nut into the rectangular opening with the nut towards the inside. Line up the threaded nut on the clip with the round hole, (**Fig 4**).

STEP 5

Attach the Assembled Driver Side Front Mounting Bracket to the installed M8 Clip Nuts with the included (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (Figs 5). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

<u>Note:</u> Depending on model/year, the brake cable may be run on the inside or outside of the Bracket.

STEP 6

Align the bottom holes of the Driver Front Mounting Bracket with the (1) hole on the pinch weld. Bolt the Bracket to the pinch weld using the included (1) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Hex Nut, (Fig 5).


NOTE: Insert the bolts up from the bottom of the pinch weld and through the Bracket. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 7

Move to the Driver Side Rear Mounting Location. Locate the mounting holes on the body panel and pinch weld, (Fig 3). Repeat **Steps 4-6** for Driver Rear Mounting Bracket installation (Fig 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 8

Once all (2) Driver side mounting brackets are installed, attach the assembled Passenger Side Bar to the Mounting Brackets with (2) M6X1-20 T-Bolts, (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers and (4) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (Fig 7). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 9

Properly level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 10

Move to the driver side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 1-9** to install driver side step bar.

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
