



STEP 1


Install (4) Pedals onto the step bars with (24) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (24) M8 Large Flat Washers and (24) M8 Lock Washers.

IMPORTANT: Don't punch the pedal with any metal hummer within pedal installation, or the pedal will be damaged.



STEP 2


Start installation at passenger side front. Insert (1) M10 Bolt Plate into the rectangular hole and out the round hole in the bottom of the side panel, (**Fig 1**).

STEP 3


Select Passenger Front Support Bracket (DFS/PFS/PRS), attach it to the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM) with (1) M8X1.25-25 Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, and (1) M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nut, (Fig 2). Leave the hardware loose at this time.



STEP 4

Select (1) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**), attach it to the M10 Bolt Plate with included (1) M10 Flat Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Nylon Lock Nut, (**Fig 3**).


NOTE: Make sure that the mounting tab on the Bracket is on the outside of the pinch weld. Line up the (2) holes in the Bracket with the factory holes in the pinch weld. Attach the Bracket to the pinch weld using the included (2) M8X1.25-35 Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Large Flat Washers and (2) M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 3**). Do not fully tighten at this time.



⁽Fig 3) Passenger Front Mounting Brackets Installed


STEP 5

Select Passenger Rear Support Bracket **(DFS/PFS/PRS)**, attach it to the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket **(PRM)** with (1) M8X1.25-25 Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, and (1) M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nut, **(Fig 4)**. Do not fully tighten at this time.



STEP 6


Move to the passenger Side Rear Mounting Location, repeat **Steps 2-4** to insert (1) M10 Bolt Plate, and assembled Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (**PRM**), (Fig 5). Do not fully tighten at this time.



STEP 7

Once all (2) brackets have been installed, select (2) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer on each T-Bolt, (**Fig 6**). Install the (2) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts with plastic washers in the slots on the assembled step bar. Rotate the T-Bolts to 90 degree, thread down the M8 Plastic Washers against the step bar (**Fig 7**).

<u>NOTE:</u> The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the T-Bolt in place to avoid falling into the tube during installation.



STEP 8

Attach the Assembled Passenger Side Step Bar onto the Mounting Brackets with (2) M8 Plastic Washers, (2) M8X1.25-20mm T-Bolts, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (2) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 8**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Slide (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into the channels at the bottom of pedals (**Fig 9**). And secure the Mounting Brackets to pedals with (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 8**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



(Fig 10) Adjustment Spacers between Vehicle Pinch Weld and Mounting Bracket


STEP 9

Depending on the model and year of the vehicle, the front of the Step Bar may be too close (or interfering) with front factory flare. If necessary, insert 1 to 3 Adjustment Spacers between the Bracket and the pinch weld to adjust the side bar on a properly position, (**Fig 10**).

STEP 10

Level and adjust the assembled Step Bar properly and tighten all hardware.

Move to the other side of the vehicle. Repeat **Steps 2-9** for the other Side Step Bar installation.



Attention Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight. In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
