



STEP 1


Starting on the driver side front of the vehicle. Select (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket (DFM), attach to the factory nut in the bottom of frame with (1) M12X1.75-120mm Hex Bolt, (1) M12 Lock Washer and (1) M12 Large Flat Washer, (Fig 1). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 2

Move to the driver side rear of the vehicle. Repeat **Step 1** for Driver Rear Mounting Bracket (DRM) installation, (Fig 2). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



STEP 3

Select a Running Board. Slip (2) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (Fig 3). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (2) Mounting Brackets.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Running Board to each Mounting Bracket with (2) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6 Ny-Ion Lock Nuts (Fig 4). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 5

Repeat **Steps 1-5** for the other side Running Board installation. The installation is completed (**Fig 5**).
