





STEP 1

Start the installation under the Passenger side of the vehicle. Remove the front body mount hex bolt, (Fig 1 & 2). Do not remove rubber bushings.





STEP 2

Hang the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM) to the body mount using the long factory hex bolt, (Fig 1 & 2). Do not fully tighten hex bolt at this time.

STEP 3

Repeat **Steps 1 & 2** for Passenger Center Mounting Bracket **(PCM)** and Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket **(PRM)** installation, **(Fig 1 & 2)**.

<u>Note:</u> No inference between the Mounting Brackets and the body mount frames.

STEP 4

Once all (3) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. According to the style of Step Bar proceed to the correct installation STEPS.

Note: Aluminum Step Bar refer to STEP 5; Stainless Steel Step Bar skip to STEP 6.

STEP 5

Aluminum Step Bar Installation:


Select a **Aluminum Step Bar**. Slip (3) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel **(Fig 3)**. Carefully position the Step Bar onto the (3) Mounting Brackets.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Step Bar on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Step Bar to each Mounting Brackets with (2) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Fig 4)**. Do not fully tighten at this time. Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

Repeat **Steps 1-5** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The** installation is completed!!!

STEP 6

Stainless Steel Step Bar Installation:

Select a **Stainless Steel Step Bar** (with the U-Sliders installed on the Bar). Loose the U-Sliders, reposition the U-Sliders onto the board according to the (3) Installed Mounting Brackets location, **(Fig 5)**. Re-secure the U-Sliders on the Step Bar. Attach the Step Bar to the installed Mounting Brackets with (6) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts, (6) M6 Large Flat Washers & (6) M6 Lock Washers, **(Fig 6)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. Repeat **Steps 1-4 and 6** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**



(Fig 5) Slide & line up the U-Slider with the installed mounting brackets along bottom channel

- (2) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts
- (2) M6 Large Flat Washers
- (2) M6 Lock Washers

IMPORTANT: TORQUE FOR 6MM FASTNERS MUST LESS THAN 6-7 FT-LBS OR THE FASTNERS WILL BE DAMAGED!
