



#### **STEP 1**


Start the installation from the Passenger Side Front Mounting Location of the vehicle. Remove the front body mount bolt, (Fig 1). Do not remove rubber bushing.

### **STEP 2**


Attach the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM) to the body mount reusing the factory hex bolt, (Fig 2). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Move to the passenger front support bracket mounting location. Locate the two factory holes at the bottom of the frame close to the Passenger Side Front Mounting Location. Insert (1) M10 Nut Plate into the oval hole and line up the threaded nut with the round hole, (Fig 3). NOTE: Nut Plate and Support Brackets are not required on 2011-2014 2500/3500 models.

#### **STEP 4**




(Fig 4) Passenger Front Support Bracket (PFS) Installed (For 1500 Models)

Attach the flat end of the Passenger Front Support Bracket (**PFS**) to the installed M10 Nut Plate with (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (1) M10 Large Flat Washer and (1) M10 Lock Washer, (**Fig 4 & 5**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.


#### 1500 Models:

Attach the bent end of the Support Bracket onto the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket with (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Large Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Hex Nut, (**Fig 4**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

#### Up to 2010 2500/3500 Models:






(Fig 6) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installed

Note that the Front Support Bracket will not reach up to the Mounting Bracket, **(Fig 5)**. Tighten the Support Bracket to the Nut Plate in the frame. Carefully push up on the Support Bracket et until it reaches the inside hole in the Mounting Bracket. Bolt the Support Bracket to the hole on the Mounting Bracket with (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Large Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Hex Nut, **(Fig 6)**. Do not fully tighten at this time.

### Note: Support Bracket not required on 2011-2014 2500/3500 Models.

(Fig 5) Passenger Front Support Bracket Installed (For 2500/3500 Models )


#### **STEP 5**

Move to the Passenger Side Center body mount and remove the factory bolt. Select the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (**PCM**). Repeat **Step 2** to attach the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (**PCM**), (**Fig 7 & 8**).

#### **STEP 6**


Next, select (1) Passenger Center Support Bracket (DCS/PCS). There are two mounting holes on the Support Bracket. Attach the Support Bracket to the hole beside the body mount with (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Large Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Hex Nut, (Fig 7 & 8). Do not fully tighten at this time.

#### **STEP 7**

Attach the opposite end of the Support Bracket to the Center Mounting Bracket with (1) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Large Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10X1.5 Hex Nut, (Fig 7 & 8). Do not fully tighten at this time.

### **STEP 8**

Move to the passenger side rear body mount. Assemble Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (**PRM**) and Passenger Rear Bar Bracket (**PRB**) with (2) M10X1.5-30 Hex Bolts, (4) M10 Large Flat Washers, (2) M10 Lock Washers and (2) M10X1.5 Hex Nuts, (**Fig 9**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. Repeat **Steps 1 - 2** to attach the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (**PRM**) to the body mount, (**Fig 10**). Do not fully tighten at this time.



(Fig 10) Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket Installation



#### **STEP 9**

Select a Running Board. Slip (5) M6x1-20 Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (**Fig 11**). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets. **IMPORTANT**: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged.

Attach the Running Board to Front & Center Mounting Brackets with (2) M6X1-20 Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts (**Fig 12**).

Attach the Running Board to Rear Bar Bracket with (6) M6X1-20 Square Head Bolts, (6) M6 Large Flat Washers and (6) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts **(Fig 13).** Do not tighten at this time.

### **STEP 10**

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hard-ware.

### STEP 11

Repeat **Steps 1-10** for the other side Running Board installation. The installation is completed (**Fig 14**).
