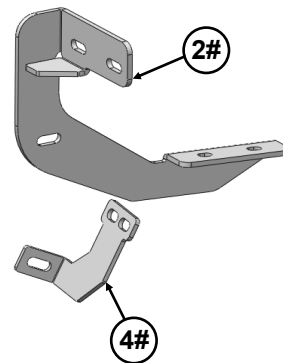
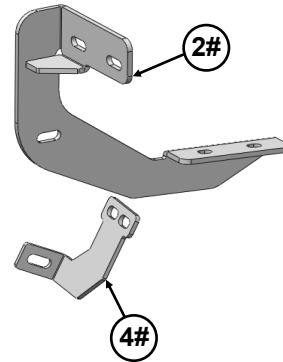
Driver Side Step Bar

Passenger Side Step Bar



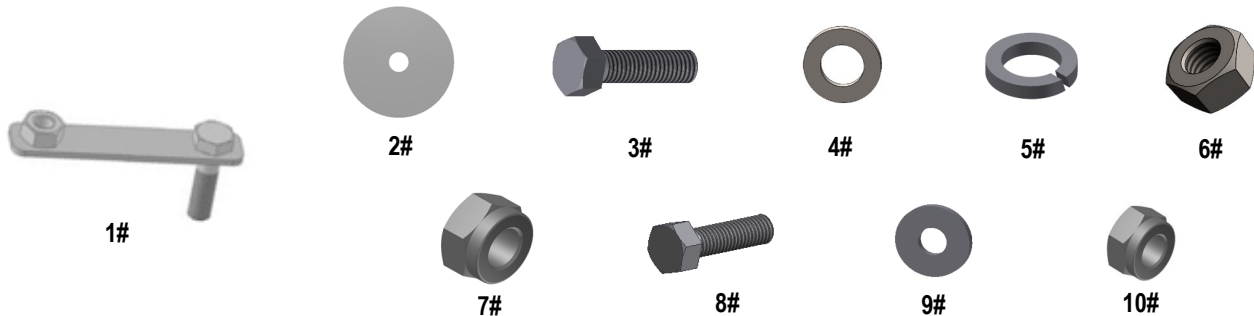

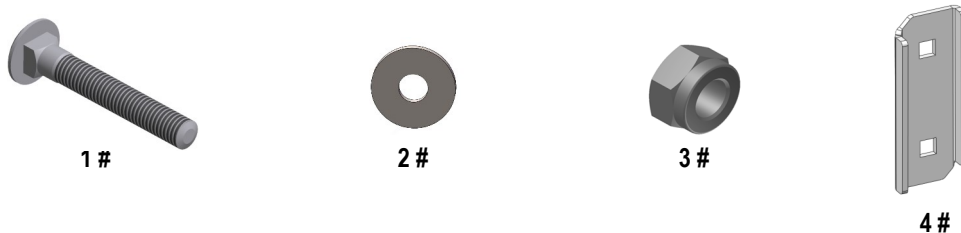

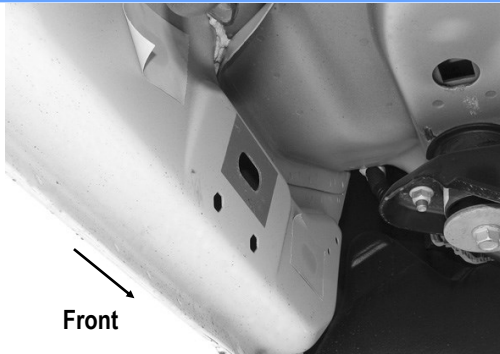

STEP 1

Starting at the driver side front of the vehicle, remove the sealing tape covering the factory holes in the side of the inner panel, (Fig 1).

(No Factory Holes In Pinch Weld on Some Models)

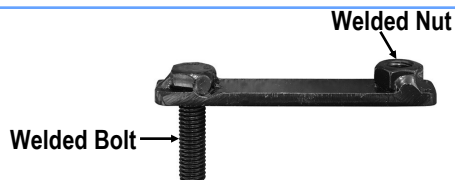
STEP 2

Determine the correct procedure to attach the Driver Front Mounting Bracket for your model/year:

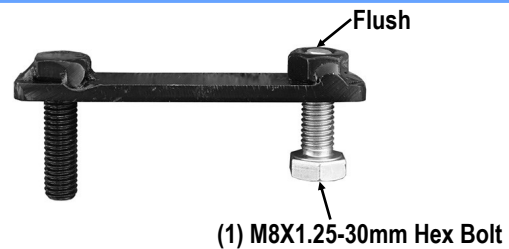
Models without factory threaded inserts in body panel:

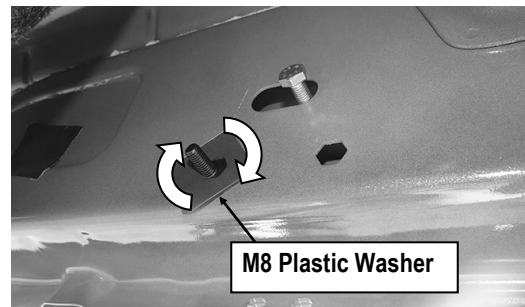
(Fig 2) M8 Bolt/Nut Plate (**NOTE:** M8 Bolt/Nut Plate Is Not Required On Models With Factory Threaded Inserts)

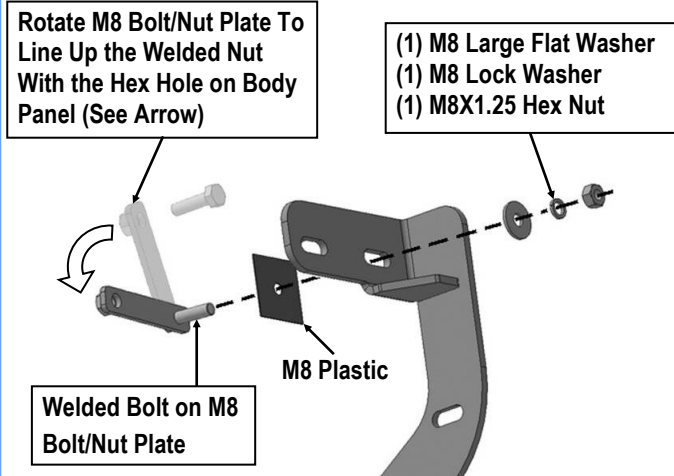


(Fig 5) Thread Plastic Washer Onto the Welded Bolt on M8 Bolt/Nut Plate To Hold Bolt/Nut Plate In Position.

- a. Select (1) M8 Bolt/Nut Plate (Fig 2). Partially thread (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt in the Welded nut on the Bolt/Nut Plate until it is flush with the welded nut, (Fig 3). Use the Hex Bolt as a handle and insert the Bolt/Nut Plate into the oval hole, (Fig 4). Feed the threaded bolt on the Bolt Plate through one of the hex factory holes. Thread (1) M8 Plastic Washer onto the welded bolt and down tight against the body panel, (Fig 5).

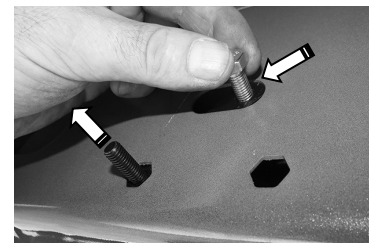
NOTE: The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the Bolt/Nut Plate out of falling into the body panel and to aid in Bracket installation.

(Fig 3) Thread (1) M8 Hex Bolt Into The Nut On The Plate. Stop When Bolt Reaches End Of Nut As Pictured



(Fig 4) Use The Loose Hex Bolt As A Handle. Insert The M8 Bolt/Nut Plate Into The Oval Hole And Feed The Welded Bolt End Out Either Factory Hex Hole on Body Panel

IMPORTANT: Do Not Remove The Hex Bolt Until The M8 Plastic Washer Has Been Threaded Onto the Welded Bolt.

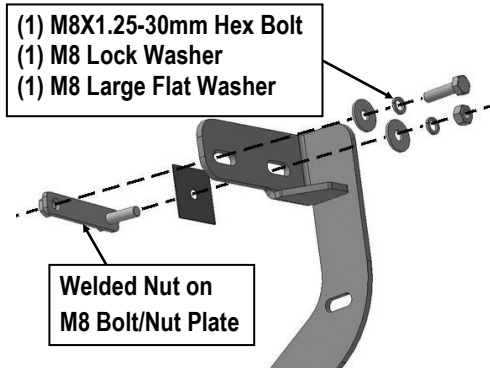
- b. Select (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket. Attach the mounting bracket to the welded bolt end of the M8 Bolt/Nut Plate with (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8X1.25 Hex Nut, (Fig 6A). Do not fully tighten at this time.

Hold the welded bolt on the M8 Bolt/Nut Plate and rotate the Bolt/Nut Plate until the welded nut lines up with the remaining hex hole on the body panel.



(Fig 6A) Attach Driver Front Mounting Bracket To the Welded Bolt on M8 Bolt/Nut Plate

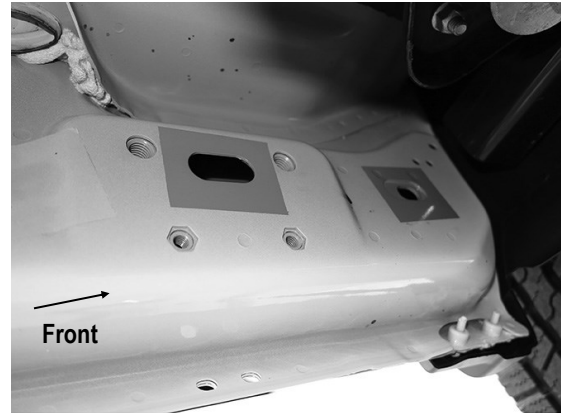

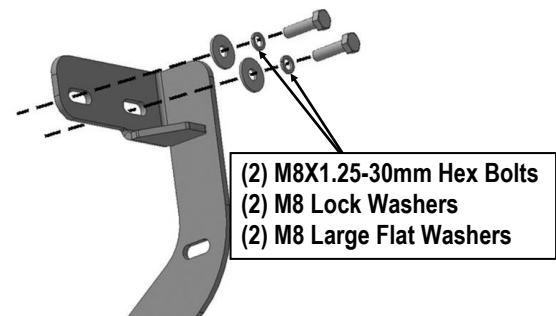
(Fig 6B) Secure Driver Front Mounting Bracket To the Welded Nut on M8 Bolt/Nut Plate

c. Secure the Driver Front Mounting Bracket to the welded nut on the M8 Bolt/Nut Plate with (1) M8x1.25- 30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer (Fig 6B). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Models with factory threaded inserts:

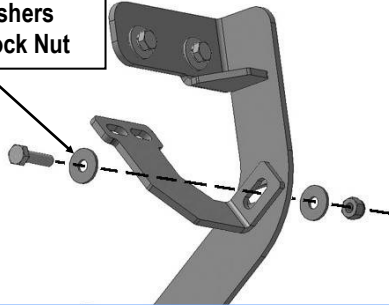
(Fig 8) Driver Front Mounting Bracket Installed (For Models With Factory Threaded Inserts. Bolt Plate Not Required)

Attach Driver Front Mounting Bracket to the threaded inserts with (2) M8x1.25-30mm Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (Fig 7 & 8). Leave hardware loose.



(Fig 7) Driver Side Front Mounting Location (Mid 2015-On, An Example Of Models With Factory Threaded Inserts)

STEP 3

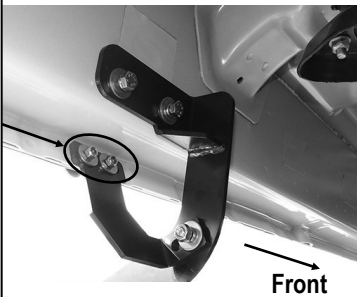
(Fig 9) Attach Driver Front Support Bracket To Front Facing Side Of the Driver Front Mounting Bracket

Attach the Driver Front Support Bracket to the Driver Front Mounting Bracket with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers and (1) M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nut, (Fig 9). Rotate the support bracket to attach the back side of the pinch weld. Line up the slots in the top of the Support Bracket with the (2) factory holes in the pinch weld. Attach the support bracket to the back of the pinch weld with (2) M6X1-25mm Hex Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (Fig 10A & 10B). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. **IMPORTANT:** Some models are not equipped with factory holes and will require drilling through the pinch weld to attach the Support Bracket. Do not drill through pinch weld at this time, (Refer to Step 6).

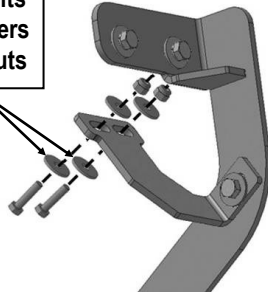


- (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt

- (1) M8X1.25 Nylon Lock Nut

- (2) M6X1-25mm Hex Bolts
- (4) M6 Large Flat Washers
- (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts



(Fig 10A) Attach Driver Front Support Bracket To the Back Of Pinch Weld (Models With Factory Holes In Pinch Weld Only)

IMPORTANT: Models w/o holes in pinch weld will require drilling 1/4" holes through pinch weld to attach Support Brackets. Do complete installation of Step Bar first and level Step Bar before drilling holes for Support Brackets (refer to Step 6).



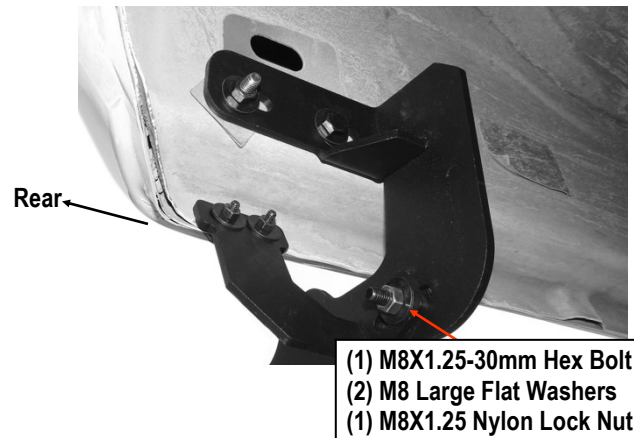
(Fig 10B) Driver Front Brackets installed

STEP 4

Move along the side of the body panel to the Driver Side Rear Mounting Location, (Figs 11). Repeat **Steps 2-3** to install the driver side rear brackets, (Fig 12).

STEP 5

Once all (2) Driver side mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. (Figs 13& 14)

- (1) Select (1) Slider and (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts;
- (2) Install (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts in (1) Slider.
- (3) Slide the Slider (with carriage bolts) to the **Step Bar**.
- (4) Repeat to install the other (1) slider to the step bar.
- (5) Attach the Step Bar (with the Sliders) onto the installed mounting brackets. Position the Sliders to the installed brackets. Secure the Step Bar to the installed Brackets by using (4) M8 Large Flat Washers and (4) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts and (2) Sliders, (Fig 14). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.



Note: The Sliders are packed with the Step Bars. Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 6

Models required drilling on Pinch Weld for driver side Support Brackets:

- Make sure the Step Bar is level to the vehicle. Adjust and tighten all mounting hardware.
- Line up the slots on the Support Brackets with the back of the pinch weld. Mark the location of the slots onto the pinch weld.
- Drill (2) 1/4" holes through the pinch weld for each Support Bracket.

IMPORTANT: Do not drill too close to the bottom edge of the pinch weld. Adjust the Brackets as necessary to move the slots

up the body panel away from the edge. Drill the holes toward the outside of the marked slots.

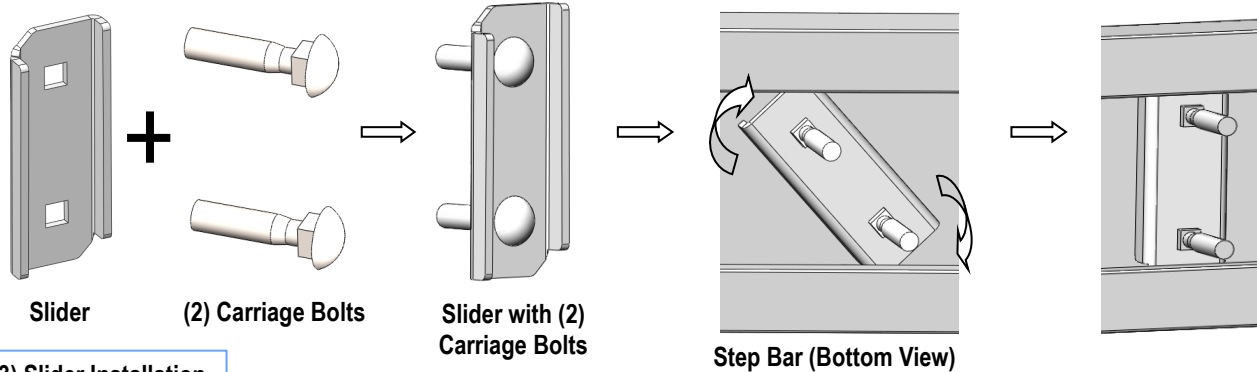
d. Attach each Support Brackets to the pinch weld with (2) M6X1-25mm Hex Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 10 & 12**). Check for level then fully tighten all hardware.

Repeat **Steps 1-6** for the other side Running Board installation. **The installation is completed.**

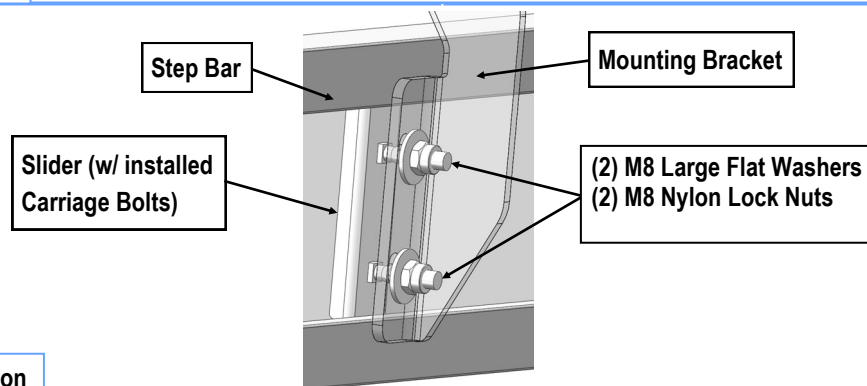
Attention
