

STEP 1


Start installation from the passenger side of the vehicle. Remove the body mount bolts from body mounts.

Select the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM), Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (PCM) and Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (PRM). Bolt the (3) mounting brackets to the vehicle with (3) M12X1.75-120mm Hex Bolts, (3) M12 Lock Washers and (3) M12 Flat Washers (Fig 1). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 2

Select a Running Board. Slip (3) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (Fig 2). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Running Board to Mounting Bracket with (6) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (6) M6 Large Flat Washers and (6) M6 X1 Nylon Lock Nuts (Fig 3). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.





STEP 3

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 4

Repeat **Steps 1-3** for the other side Running Board installation. The installation is completed, (**Fig 4**).
