



STEP 1


(Fig 1) Passenger Side Front Mounting Location

Start installation from the passenger side front of the vehicle. Locate and remove the (3) rubber plugs at the bottom of the outer frame channel closest to the front wheel opening, (**Fig 1**).

STEP 2

Select (2) M10X35 Bolt Plates and (2) M10 Plastic Washers. Partially thread the M10 Plastic Washer onto the Bolt Plates. **NOTE**: The Plastic Washer is designed to hold the Bolt Plate in place during Bracket installation.

Insert (1) M10X35 Bolt Plate into the most front hole with the plate pointed toward the rear of the vehicle, (**Fig 2**). Thread the M10 Plastic Washer down tight against the body panel. Repeat to install the next M10X35 Bolt Plate into the second hole with the Mounting Plate pointed toward the front of the vehicle, (**Fig 3**).


Note: The Plates on the (2) Bolt Plates must be pointed toward each other, (Fig 3).

STEP 3

Select (1) Mounting Plate, (Fig 3). Attach the Mounting Plate over the installed (2) M10X35 Bolt Plates. Secure the Mounting Plate to the rear Bolt Plate only with (1) M10 Large Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (Fig 4). Tighten the Hex Nut at this time.



(Fig 4) Mounting Plate Installed (on the Passenger Side Front Mounting Location)



STEP 4




(Fig 5) M10X35 Bolt Plate Installed (on the Inner Side Of The Body Panel)

Locate the round hole on the body panel directly behind the previously installed (2) Bolt Plates, **(Figs 1 & 5)**. Remove the rubber plug if equipped. Insert (1) M10X35 Bolt Plate into the round hole. And thread (1) M10 Plastic Washer onto the Bolt Plate down tight against the body panel.

IMPORTANT: Mounting areas may cover by undercoating. Brackets should attach on the body panel flatly. Remove the undercoating on the bracket mounting area, if necessary.

STEP 5

Select (1) Passenger Front "L" Outer Support Bracket (DFS/ PFS). Attach the shorter end of the Passenger Front "L" Outer Support Bracket to the installed front Bolt Plate with (1) M10 Large Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (Fig 6). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.


Note: Passenger Front "L" Outer Support Bracket **(DFS/PFS)** and Passenger Rear "7" Outer Support Bracket **(DRS/PRS)** are different.

STEP 6


Select the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM**). Attach the bracket to the installed M10X35 Bolt Plate on the inner side of the body panel with (1) M10 Large Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (**Fig 7**). And then, secure the Mounting Bracket to the installed Passenger Front "L" Outer Support Bracket (**DFS/PFS**) with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Hex Nut, (**Fig 8**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 7

Move to the Passenger / Drive Front Long Support Brackets (DFS1 / PFS1) installation. Locate the factory holes in the bottom of the inner frame channel. Determine the correct mounting hole:


Driver side : Use the front factory hole, (Fig 9).


(Fig 10) Passenger Front Long Support Bracket Location

Passenger side: Use the rear factory hole, (Fig 10).


Select (1) M10X35 Bolt Plate and (1) M10 Plastic Washer. Partially thread the M10 Plastic Washer onto the Bolt Plate. Insert the Bolt Plate into the correct factory hole in the frame channel (Fig 9 & 10).


(Fig 11) Driver Front Long Support Bracket (DFS1) Installation

Attach the shorter end of the Front Long Support Bracket to the installed M10X35 Bolt Plate with (1) M10 Large Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (Figs 11-13).


Bolt the other end of the Front Long Support Bracket to the front Mounting Bracket with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Hex Nut, (**Figs 11-13**). Do not fully tighten at this time.



(Fig 9) Driver Front Long Support Bracket Location




(Fig 12) Passenger Front Long Support Bracket (PFS1) Installation



STEP 8

Move to the passenger side rear mounting location. Locate the large oval and the round holes on the inner body panel in front of the rear tire, (Fig 14). Select (1) M10X35 Double Bolt Plate and (1) M10 Plastic Washer. Insert the M10X35 Bolt Plate into the oval hole and up and out of the smaller round hole above it. Thread the Plastic Washer onto the M10X35 Bolt Plate in the round hole only, (Fig 15).




STEP 9




(Fig 17) Mounting Plate Installation

Locate the last (2) round holes along the floor panel, (Fig 16). Repeat Steps 1-3 to install the (2) M10X35 Bolt Plates and (1) Mounting Plate, (Fig 16 & 17) NOTE: Attach the Mounting Plate to the front of M10X35 Bolt Plate only with (1) M10 Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (Fig 17). Tighten the Hex Nut at this time.


STEP 10

Select the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (**PRM**). Attach the Mounting Bracket to the M10X35 Double Bolt Plate with (2) M10 Large Flat Washers, (2) M10 Lock Washers and (2) M10 Hex Nuts, (**Fig 18**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Next, attach the Passenger Rear Bar Bracket (**PRB**) to the front of the Mounting Bracket with (2) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Large Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 X1.25 Hex Nuts, (**Fig 19**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

(Fig 19) Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket And Passenger Rear Bar Bracket Assembly


STEP 11


Attach the Passenger Rear 7 Support Bracket to the rear of M10X35 Bolt Plate with (1) M10 Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, **(Fig 20 & 21)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Bolt the Passenger Rear 7 Support Bracket to the back of the Passenger Rear Bar Bracket with (1) M8X1.25-30mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Hex Nut, (Fig 20 & 21). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.









STEP 12

Once all (2) Passenger side mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. (Figs 22 & 23)

- (1) Select (1) Slider and (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts;
- (2) Install (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts in (1) Slider.
- (3) Slide the Slider (with carriage bolts) to the Step Bar.
- (4) Repeat to install the other (1) slider to the step bar.

(5) Attach the Step Bar (with the Sliders) onto the installed mounting brackets. Position the Sliders to the installed brackets. Secure the Step Bar to the installed Brackets by using (4) M8 Large Flat Washers and (4) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts and (2) Sliders, (**Fig 23**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Note: The Sliders are packed with the Mounting Brackets.

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware.

Repeat **Steps 1-12** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

In order to protect your bars/boards, please use mild soap/non-abrasive products for cleaning only.
