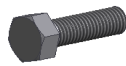

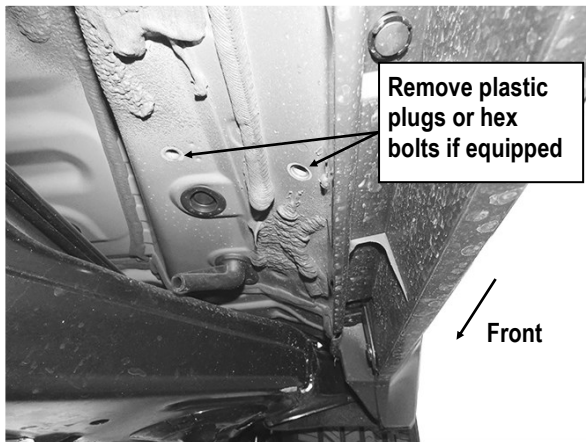

STEP 1

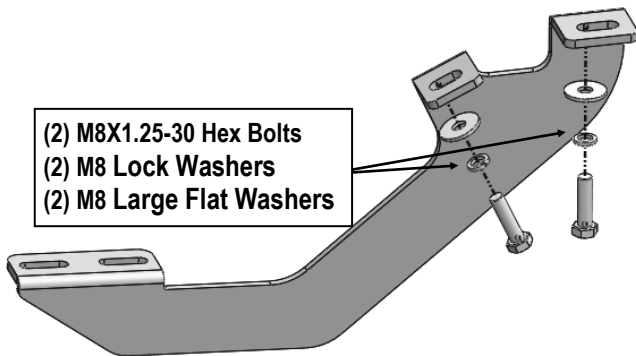
Start installing on the passenger side front of the vehicle. Remove the plastic plugs or hex bolts from the mounting location if equipped, (Fig 1).

STEP 2

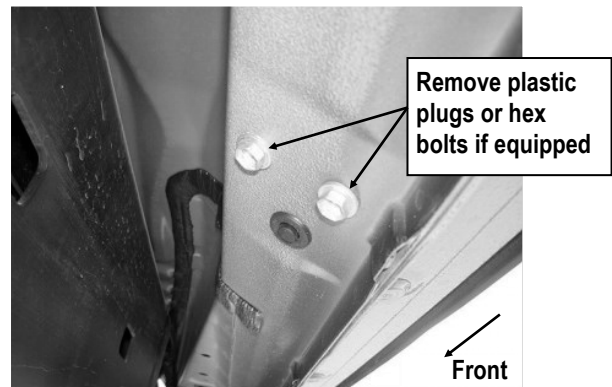
(Fig 2) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installation



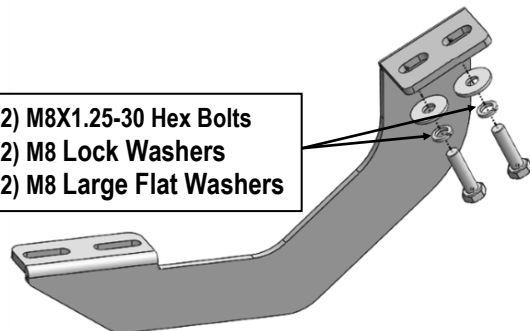
(Fig 3) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket Installed

Select the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM). Attach the Bracket to the mounting location with (2) M8X1.25-30 Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (Figs 2&3). Do not fully tighten at this time.

STEP 3

Repeat Steps 1-2 to attach the (3) Passenger Center / Rear Mounting Brackets (PCM/PRM) to the mounting locations, (Fig 4&5). Do not fully tighten at this time.

STEP 4

Once all (4) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. According to the style of Step Bar proceed to the correct installation STEPS.

Note: Aluminum Step Bar refer to STEP 5; Stainless Steel Step Bar skip to STEP 6.

STEP 5

Aluminum Step Bar Installation:

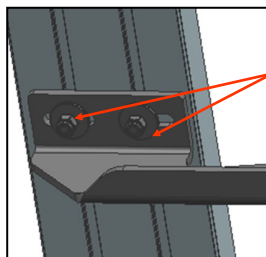
Select a **Aluminum Step Bar**. Slide (4) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel (**Fig 6**). Carefully position the Step Bar onto the (4) Mounting Brackets.

IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Step Bar on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Step Bar to each Mounting Brackets with (2) M6X1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6X1 Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Fig 7**). Do not fully tighten at this time.

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. Repeat **Steps 1-5** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**

IMPORTANT: TORQUE FOR 6MM FASTNERS MUST LESS THAN 6-7 FT-LBS OR THE FASTNERS WILL BE DAMAGED!

STEP 6

Stainless Steel Step Bar Installation:

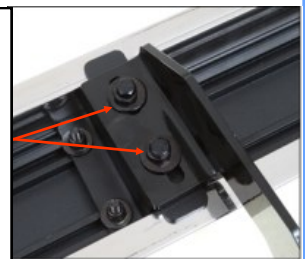
Select a **Stainless Steel Step Bar** (with the U-Sliders installed on the Bar). Loose the U-Sliders, reposition the U-Sliders onto the board according to the (4) Installed Mounting Brackets location, (**Fig 8**). Re-secure the U-Sliders on the Step Bar. Attach the Step Bar to the installed Mounting Brackets with (8) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts, (8) M6 Large Flat Washers & (8) M6 Lock Washers, (**Fig 9**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. Repeat **Steps 1-4 and 6** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**



(Fig 8) Slide & line up the U-Slider with the installed mounting brackets along bottom channel

(2) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts
(2) M6 Large Flat Washers
(2) M6 Lock Washers

IMPORTANT: TORQUE FOR 6MM FASTNERS MUST LESS THAN 6-7 FT-LBS OR THE FASTNERS WILL BE DAMAGED!
