



### STEP 1

Start installation from the driver side front of the vehicle, locate the (3) mounting holes in the body support.


Partially attach a Driver Front Mounting Bracket **(DFM)** to the center mounting hole in the vehicle using (1) M10X1.5-25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M10 Flat Washers, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut. Use the included (2) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers, (4) M8 Large Flat Washers and (2) M8 Hex Nuts in the remaining inner and outer mounting holes, **(Fig 1)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

### STEP 2

Move to the driver side rear of the vehicle. Repeat **Step 1** to install the Driver Rear Mounting Bracket (**DRM**), (**Fig 2**).

### STEP 3

Once all (2) mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. According to the style of Step Bar proceed to the correct installation STEPS.

Note: Aluminum Step Bar refer to STEP 4; Stainless Steel Step Bar skip to STEP 5.

#### STEP 4

#### **Aluminum Step Bar Installation:**


Select a **Aluminum Step Bar**. Slip (2) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts into each bottom channel **(Fig 3)**. Carefully position the Step Bar onto the (2) Mounting Brackets.

**IMPORTANT**: Do not slide the Step Bar on the Brackets or the bottom surface of the board will be damaged. Attach the Step Bar to each Mounting Brackets with (2) M6x1-20mm Square Head Bolts, (2) M6 Large Flat Washers and (2) M6 Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Fig 4)**. Do not fully tighten at this time.

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. Repeat **Steps 1-4** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**

### STEP 5

#### **Stainless Steel Step Bar Installation:**

Select a **Stainless Steel Step Bar** (with the U-Sliders installed on the Bar). Loose the U-Sliders, reposition the U-Sliders onto the board according to the (2) Installed Mounting Brackets location, **(Fig 5)**. Re-secure the U-Sliders on the Step Bar. Attach the Step Bar to the installed Mounting Brackets with (4) M6X1-20mm Hex Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers & (4) M6 Lock Washers, **(Fig 6)**. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. Repeat **Steps 1-3 and 5** for the other side Step Bar installation. **The installation is completed!!!**
