



STEP 1

Passenger Side Step Bar Assembly:

- Select and assemble (2) Step Bars with (2) M8X1.25-25mm Inner Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Nuts, (Fig 1). NOTE: (2) Step Bars are universal.
- 2. Attach (1) Back Plate to the bottom of the installed (2) Step Bars with (4) M8X1.25-25mm Inner Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers, (4) M8 Lock Washers, (Fig 2).
- 3. Install (1) Plastic Cover to cover the joint of (2) Step bars with (4) Plastic Rivets, (Fig 3).









STEP 2




(Fig 4) Passenger Side Front & Center Mounting Locations

Starting on the passenger front side of the vehicle, locate the factory holes in the inner body panel closest to the front tire opening, (Fig 4). Remove the rubber plugs if equipped.

STEP 3


(Fig 5) M10 Bolt Plate Installed (On Passenger Side Front & Center Mounting Location)

Select (2) M10 Bolt Plate and (2) M10 Plastic Washer. Insert the M10 Bolt Plates into the mounting holes and thread (1) M10 Plastic Washer on each Bolt Plate to hold the bolt plates in place, (Fig 5).

IMPORTANT: The Plastic Washer is designed to keep the Bolt Plate from falling into the body panel during bracket installation.

STEP 4




(Fig 6) Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM/PCM) and Passenger Front Support Bracket (PFS/PCS) Installation

Attach the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (**PFM/PCM**) to the installed M10 Bolt Plate with (1) M10 Flat Washer, (1) M10 Lock Washer and (1) M10 Hex Nut, (**Fig 6**). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 5

Next, select (1) Passenger Front Support Bracket (PFS/PCS). Attach the Support Bracket to the back of the Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (PFM/PCM) with (1) M8X1.25-25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Large Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock washer and (1) M8 Hex Nuts, (Fig 6). Line up the mounting flange on the Support Bracket with the back of the pinch weld, (Fig 7). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 6


Move to the passenger side center mounting location. Repeat **Steps 2—5** to install the Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (**PFM/PCM**) and Passenger Center Support Bracket (**PFS/PCS**).

Note: Passenger Front & Center Mounting Bracket (**PFM/PCM**) are universal; Passenger Front & Center Support Bracket (**PFS/PCS**) are universal.


STEP 7

Move to the passenger side rear mounting location, (Fig 8). Repeat Steps 2—5 to install the Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (PRM) and Passenger Rear Support Bracket (DFS/DRS/PRS), (Fig 9 & 10).


Note: Passenger Rear Support Bracket, Driver Front Support Bracket and Driver Center Support Bracket are universal.

STEP 8


Once all (3) Passenger side mounting brackets are installed, then proceed to the Step Bar installation. (Figs 11 & 12)

- (1) Select (1) Slider and (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts;
- (2) Install (2) M8X1.25-35mm Carriage Bolts in (1) Slider.
- (3) Slide the Slider (with carriage bolts) to the **Step Bar**.
- (4) Repeat to install the other (2) sliders to the step bar.
- (5) Attach the Step Bar (with the Sliders) onto the installed mounting brackets. Position the Sliders to the installed brackets. Secure the Step Bar to the installed Brackets by using (6) M8 Large Flat Washers and (6) M8 Nylon Lock Nuts and (3) Sliders, (Fig 12). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.

Note: The Sliders are packed with the Step Bars.




STEP 9


(Fig 13) Mark location of each Support Bracket onto pinch weld before drilling

Make sure the Brackets are level to the vehicle. Line up the slots on each Support Bracket with the back of the pinch weld. Mark the location of the slots onto the pinch weld, (Fig 13).

IMPORTANT: Do not drill too close to the bottom edge of the pinch weld. Adjust Support Brackets and/or Mounting Brackets to move slot in support bracket up away from the bottom edge of the pinch weld.

Once the Step Bar and Brackets are properly adjusted and slot locations marked, remove the Step Bar and Support Brackets. Use a 1/4" drill bit to drill the (2) holes through the pinch weld for each Support Bracket, (Fig 13). NOTE: Drill holes toward outer ends of slot. Avoid drilling through welds in pinch weld.

STEP 10




(Fig 14) Attach Support Bracket To Pinch Weld

Attach each Support Bracket to the pinch weld with (2) M6X1-25mm Hex Bolts, (4) M6 Large Flat Washers, (2) M6 Lock Washers and (2) M6 Hex Nuts, (Fig 14). Repeat this Step to attach all (3) Support Brackets. Tighten the hardware attaching the Support Brackets to the vehicle only.

STEP 11

Move to the Driver side of the vehicle (Fig 15). Repeat Steps 2 -5 to install the driver side front and rear Mounting Brackets and Support Brackets, (Fig 16). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.


Note: Driver Front & Rear Mounting Bracket (**DFM/DRM**) are universal; Passenger Rear Support Bracket, Driver Front Support Bracket and Driver Center Support Bracket are universal.

STEP 12

Repeat **Steps 9—10** to drill holes on the pinch weld and install the support brackets, **(Fig 15)**, and install the Driver Side Step Bar (the short one).

STEP 13

Level and adjust the Step Bar and fully tighten all hardware. **Installation completed.**

Attention

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
