## PROCEDURE:

1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. USE ILLUSTRATION TO IDENTIFY BRACKETS.
2. Starting on the Driver/Left front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs, (or hex bolts), covering the threaded holes in the body panel, (Figure 1). Select the Driver/Left Front Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the vehicle with (2) 8 mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8 mm Lock Washers and (2) 8 mm Flat Washers, (Figure 2). Do not tighten hardware.
3. Move along the body panel to the center mounting location. Select (1) Driver/Left Rear Mounting Bracket. Repeat Step 2 to install the Mounting Bracket, (Figures 3 \& 4). Do not tighten hardware.
4. Continue to the last mounting location at the back of the cab, (Figure 5). Select the remaining (1) Driver/Left Rear Mounting Bracket. Repeat Step 2 to attach the Bracket to the rear mounting location. Do not tighten hardware.
5. Select the Driver/Left Tube. Insert (2) 8 mm Triangle Double Bolt Plates into the front (2) sets of (2) holes, (Figure 6). Attach (1) Drop Step to the (2) Double Bolt Plates with (4) $8 \mathrm{~mm} \times 22 \mathrm{~mm}$ Flat Washers and (4) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figure 7). Do not tighten hardware.
6. With assistance, line up the mounting tabs in the Driver/Left Tube to the rear faces of the Mounting Brackets. Secure the Tube to the Mounting Brackets with (6) 10 mm Hex Bolts, (12) $10 \mathrm{~mm} \times 20 \mathrm{~mm}$ Flat Washers and (6) 10 mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figure 8). Do not tighten hardware.
7. Level and adjust the Overland Step, then tighten all hardware.
8. Repeat Steps $\mathbf{1 - 7}$ to attach the Passenger/Right Overland Step.
9. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Overland Steps.
